



## MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

**There are four (4) membership categories:**

1. Active Members
2. Inactive Members
3. Affiliated Supporting Members
4. Institutional Members

### **1. Active Members**

The following are considered active members: student or former student members with disabilities and individual supporting members.

Active members may attend and speak at meetings and become members of the Board of Directors. They are eligible to vote.

#### **a) Student or Former Student Members with Disabilities - FREE**

The following are considered student members/former student members with disabilities:

- Any student with a disability who is currently registered, or who, within the last ten (10) years, was registered in at least one (1) course in a public or private post-secondary educational institution or in professional training school.
- Associations of students with disabilities in post-secondary educational institutions.
- Any student with a disability enrolled in general education grade 10 or 11 (secondary 4 or 5).

#### **b) Individual Supporting Members - \$5 the first year**

Any individual, non-profit organization or other legally incorporated body interested in the activities conducted by the association who can offer a significant contribution will be eligible to become an individual supporting member.





## **2. Inactive Members**

Any active member, student or former student with a disability or individual supporting member who has not renewed their annual participation by submitting a new application for membership will be eligible to become an inactive member. Inactive members may attend and speak at meetings, but they cannot vote.

## **3. Affiliated Supporting Members - \$20 per year**

Any non-profit organization legally constituted interested in the activities conducted by the Association that can offer a significant contribution will be eligible to become an affiliated supporting member.

Affiliated supporting members may attend and speak at meetings, but are not eligible to vote, unless they are members of the Board of Directors.

## **4. Institutional Members - \$50 per year**

Any educational institution or profit-making organization interested in the activities conducted by the association that can offer a significant contribution will be eligible to become an institutional member.

Institutional members may attend and speak at meetings, but are not allowed to vote, unless they are members of the Board of Directors.

Only active members meeting the conditions provided under Article 9 are voting members.
